A. Separately, type a brief essay, 200 to 300 words, describing your interests in the environment and conservation. Include reasons for your interest in the specific camp or service project of your choice. The topic is up to the applicant and is not as important as conveying the applicant's interest in the environment and conservation. Write about the basis for your interests. What caught your attention to the outdoors, or ecology, botany, marine science, hiking, camping, etc? Did a person or experience spark your interests? Was it a hike in the woods or a canoe trip on the river? Explain how you spend time outdoors; your participation in environmental projects; your future aspirations for conservation education or career. Or discuss how you would persuade others to enjoy and protect the outdoors as much as you do. Include a poem or drawing with the essay if it helps you express yourself. As always, correct spelling and proper grammar will be considered as important to a successful applicant.

B. For community service project applicants, submit a proposal for your project on the attached service project form.

C. Include brief, written recommendations from two adults who recognize your interests in the environment and conservation. One or two paragraphs is sufficient.
